

Tenure-Track Faculty Position in Health Psychology

The Department of Psychology at Kent State University seeks applicants for a tenure-track faculty position in Health Psychology at the Assistant Professor level beginning in Fall 2012, pending final budgetary approval. A Ph.D. in psychology is required.

Successful candidates will be expected to develop a highly productive research program, secure extramural funding, and exhibit a commitment to teaching graduate and undergraduate courses. Candidates will contribute to our experimental graduate training programs in social and health psychology, and should complement existing research programs in social relationships, stress and coping, and health behavior. We are particularly interested in candidates who have expertise linking psychological processes (social, behavioral) with biological processes and health outcomes. Our faculty are highly productive researchers who have demonstrated success in attracting substantial federal funding in support of their research programs. The Department of Psychology's health research is facilitated by strong, collaborative ties with several local hospitals.
