HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS/ ALTERNATE EDUCATION

Kent State welcomes applications from home-schooled students. Students may submit a portfolio reflecting all secondary coursework completed, written verification from the appropriate school district excusing the student from compulsory attendance and an ACT or SAT score OR students may submit an equivalent diploma through a successful General Education Development (GED) test and an ACT or SAT score. Home-schooled students should complete a program of study that covers the full college-preparatory program recommended by the Ohio State Board of Education. Out-of-state students should submit appropriate supporting documents as required by their home state.
