Located in scenic and historic Boston, the Massachusetts General Hospital is a world renowned medical institution and is the flagship teaching hospital of the Harvard Medical School. This CPME approved PM&S-36 program is well-rounded, highly structured and designed for the mature, responsible, self-disciplined and self-motivated resident. We provide rigorous training experiences in more than 20 diverse (1 month block) medical and surgical disciplines, combined with readily available academic and other educational resources, including extensive library facilities on campus. Established over 20 years ago, the program and Podiatry Service enjoy an excellent working relationship with the other hospital departments and the medical staff.

The PGY-I & -II years provide a strong educational foundation in medicine and surgery. Advancement to the PGY-III year provides an opportunity for more extensive training and education in foot & ankle surgery, including podiatry, orthopedics, orthopedic trauma & plastic surgery. Under the supervision of attendings, PGY-II & -III residents manage their own patients as a longitudinal, hospital-based, out-patient clinic experience. When on non-podiatric medical and surgical rotations, our residents function as integral team members along with other residents, fellows and medical students.

Residents receive an excellent salary and benefits package, identical to all other residents at the same PGY levels at the hospital. In addition, all residents receive ACLS training, Podiatry Residency Resource enrollment, PRESENT Courseware enrollment and a generous CME allowance. Each resident has a dedicated office, with computer and internet access. As travel to affiliated institutions is necessary, access to an automobile is essential, especially for PGY-II & III surgical rotations and responsibilities

We accept student applicants from all podiatric medical colleges, and have one entry level position available each academic year, beginning on July 1. Although our externship is currently inactive, we encourage interested students to arrange times to visit.
