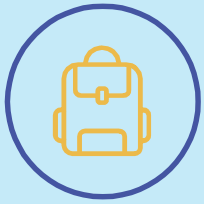


Addictions Counseling Certificate Program (ACCP)

Overview:

- A 16-credit non-degree certificate
- 5 CES courses in 12-month sequence at Kent + Trumbull + 100% online
- Offered to KSU undergraduates enrolled in behavioral science degree or nursing program + non-degree seeking post-undergraduate KSU students
- Former KSU students or students currently enrolled elsewhere can transfer up to 6 credits towards ACCP
- Total training hours = 195, granting licensure eligibility as a chemical dependency counselor in Ohio
- Practicum experience ranging from 315-840 field hours at local treatment facilities

2. CES 34650 – Practices & Theories in Addictions Counseling
3. CES 37665 – Planning Care in Addictions Counseling
4. CES 34654 – Evidence-based Approaches in Addictions Counseling*
5. CES 37692 – Addictions Counseling Practicum
