

Nomination and Online Application Procedures

NOMINATION	Sending institutions must nominate students through the Online Nomination Form. Deadlines • Fall Semester, Spring Semester and Full Year stays, 30th April 2024 • Spring Semester: 29th September 2024
ONLINE APPLICATION	Once nominated, students will receive a confirmation from our International Office, together with an incoming student guide and a link to do their Online Application on our MoveOn platform. Deadlines • Fall Semester (S1): 19th May 2024 • Spring Semester (S2): 20th October 2024 Students are not required to select their classes at this point yet.
ACCEPTATION	WARNING: selected classes before the arrival can be modified during the first week of the stay, due to last minute timetable modifications.
COURSE CHANGES	Course change requests will be acceptable depending on the <u>sports</u> availability. Enrolment modification period S1: within a month since the exchange started
