Construction work that surrounds the Art Annex will be taking place throughout the fall and spring semesters. The construction crews will be working diligently to keep all of you safe while they complete their work. But they need your help. By following a few simple steps we can all stay safe and have a productive year:

- Be aware of your surroundings at all times
- When entering and exiting the Art Annex please refrain from using cell phones or any other device that might impair your hearing (i.e. ear buds, headphones, etc.)
- Look above for potential overhead loads, do not walk underneath if present
- There will be active construction near you, keep this in mind at all times
- Listen for backup alarms and watch for moving construction vehicles
- Yield to oncoming traffic
- Do not open closed gates or cross over into the construction zone
- Obey all posted site signage
- Do not loiter in the area highlighted in yellow, unless a vehicle is present please move efficiently through to the other side
- Check with your instructors about safe times to drop off and pick up your personal goods, supplies, or materials. Typically this will be after 4pm Monday through Friday and Weekends when construction is not actively occurring.
