



KSU has a holistic approach to application review. We consider several factors, including your classroom performance in core academic courses, strength of high school curriculum and cumulative GPA. The process is selective, and we consider every applicant individually. We will consider your ACT and SAT scores, but these scores are not required to apply for admission.


