The purpose of this meeting is to discuss course registration for the following semester and to make any necessary adjustments in your prospectus. You have 9 years to complete your Ph.D. program. This time limit begins when you take your first course toward the degree; or if you are seeking to transfer courses, your time limit begins with the earliest of those transferred courses. Kent State University requires Ph.D. students to complete a minimum of 90 hours beyond the bachelor's degree and 60 hours beyond the master's degree.

#### **SINGLE MAJOR**

Single Major and/or Single Minor or Cognate: Minimum of two members.

- Major advisor (or co-advisor) assigned by the program area
- Second member (or co-advisor) may be from the major program area
- Note 1: Up-to-date lists of full and associate members of the College and Graduate School of Education, Health, and Human Services are maintained in the Office of Administrative Affairs and Graduate Education, 409 White Hall.
- Note 2: Any change in committee structure requires the filing of a revised form.
  - If the major advisor has associate graduate faculty rank, the co-advisor or second major advisor must hold full graduate faculty rank.
