This time limit begins when you take your first course toward the degree; or if you are seeking to transfer courses, your time limit begins with the earliest of those transferred courses. Kent State University requires Ph.D. students to complete a minimum of 90 hours beyond the bachelor's degree and 60 hours beyond the master's degree.
