1. Please be advised that the Plan of Study (this form) should be completed/signed and submitted to the *Office of Graduate Student Services* no later than the end of the second semester of coursework in the program. Students will be blocked from registering for the third semester after admittance (including summer) until a Plan of Study has been filed. 2. Application for Graduation is required no later than the first Friday of the semester you plan to graduate. It is your responsibility to apply for graduation by the deadline. The Application for Graduation is completed through [Flashline](#) (under the Student Tab, click on "Resources", then "Graduation").
3. Completion of all licensure content coursework and MAT professional coursework is a prerequisite to being recommended by Kent State University for licensure; licenses are granted by the Ohio Department of Education.
4. **Licensure Requirement (not required for graduation):** Candidates seeking Ohio licensure are required to pass specific assessments in order to apply for licensure. Students should consult their advisors for specific program requirements and refer to the Ohio Department of Education's [Educator License Exams - Initial Licensure webpage](#) for more information on assessments specific to licensure type.
5. Upon successful completion of all program requirements and licensure assessments, candidates seeking Ohio licensure must apply for the teaching license by completing the *Licensure Pre-Application* located in the [Student Portal](#). Once the Licensure Pre-Application is completed, the system will then link the candidate to the Ohio Department of Education's application website to complete the application process and make payment.
