Dear Prospective Student:

Recently you expressed interest in the *Early Childhood Education Master of Arts in Teaching* (ECED MAT) program which leads to initial licensure for preschool to grade 5 (the Ohio Primary License). This program also allows you to earn a level one Primary Years Program certificate with the International Baccalaureate (IB).

Our next ECED MAT cohort will be offered in Summer 2025 with an application deadline of February 1, 2025.

(The online application process for Summer 2025 programs should OPEN in late Summer 2024).

Pre-Admission Transcript Review for Prerequisite Coursework:

Transcripts will be continuously reviewed for prerequisites in math, science, American history, geography and child development leading up to the application deadline. Please email Erin Harwood, Graduate Senior Advisor (eharwood@kent.edu), to request a prerequisite transcript review (attach unofficial transcripts). If you are a current Kent State undergraduate student or a graduate of Kent State, transcripts can be accessed internally with your written authorization to access your Kent State record embedded in your email.

Any undergraduate prerequisite coursework deemed necessary can be taken at any Kent State campus, or any other accredited institution (please work with Erin Harwood, Graduate Senior Advisor, to ensure transferability). Prerequisite coursework should be completed no later than May 2025 before the program begins.

Formal Admission Process:

The admission process to the ECED MAT program is handled entirely online. Applications for the Summer 2025 cohort will be accepted starting late Summer 2024 (when the application opens for Summer 2025 programs). The application deadline for the Summer 2025 ECED MAT cohort is <u>February 1, 2025</u>. Your application will be processed by GRADUATE ADMISSIONS:

All master's applications submitted are assessed a \$45 non-refundable application fee. Please understand that applications to our initial teacher licensure programs, including the ECED MAT, are reviewed as a cohort (per accreditation standards) after the February 1, 2025 deadline. Early submission of your application does not mean an early admission decision.

Once you submit your application and pay the application fee, you will no longer be able to edit the application. However, you can continue to upload any unfinished admission documents, including unofficial transcripts, at a later time through your status page on your applicant portal (available once you submit your app/app fee). Please be aware that your application will not be forwarded to the College of EHHS for review until all outstanding requirements have been satisfied.

Admission Requirements:

Applicants will be assessed holistically, considering: academic credentials; academic or professional references; non-academic dimensions; and other specific program criteria.

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- Minimum 2.75 undergraduate (cumulative/overall) GPA
- Official transcript(s) [Must submit all transcripts from colleges/universities (other than Kent State) in which 8 or more semester credit hours were attempted. You may upload copies of UNOFFICIAL transcripts to speed up app process but if offered admission, you are required to submit OFFICIAL transcripts directly from all institutions.]
- <u>Two recommendations</u> [It is HIGHLY recommended you use the online application recommender system; you only need to submit names/emails of two recommenders-you do not need to submit letters. Suggested recommenders can include college professors, supervisors, colleagues, etc]
- Supplemental Data Form [embedded within the online application]
- <u>Goal Statement</u> [This statement should encompass your rationale for pursuing initial licensure in Early Childhood Education. It may reflect on past career, education and family choices. Limit document to 300 words, double-spaced]
- Questions in Anticipation of Licensure form [form is embedded within online application]
- Interview [Conducted after application submission AND prior to full acceptance into the program]




- Review the page and click "Apply Now"

(You can go in and out of the portal as you like to complete your application, and you can visit it to check the status of your application.)


A few hints/screenshots as you enter the information in the online application:

- Under <u>Initial Questions Graduate</u> tab: SELECT "Masters" for the degree or credential you are pursuing (even though you are also pursuing licensure)
- Under <u>Academic Plan Graduate</u> tab: Scroll down through "College of Education, Health & Human Services, Masters" until you find "Early Childhood Education-<u>MAT</u>" (do NOT select "Early Childhood Education-MEd")
- Under "Intended Start Term"-SELECT: Summer 2025 (this program only starts in summer)
