Explain the purpose for this proposal:

Create a new course as a "second internship" experience for students in the ATTR major. Students currently repeat the internship course. We are splitting the internship into two separate courses - Internship in ATTR I and Internship in ATTR II so that students can have a year-long internship experience as part of the senior culminating experience.

Explain how this proposal affects program requirements and students in your unit:

This course will be added as a major requirement increasing credit hours for courses counted in major GPA. However, general elective hours will be reduced so there will not be an increase in total credit hours for the degree.

It is an ATTR program change only. No other programs will be impacted.

Explain how this proposal affects enrollment and staffing:

Internship was already taught each semester so there are no staffing or enrollment issues. Students will take Internship II in the spring semester of the senior year.
