All candidates for the Educational Psychology (EPSY) Master of Education degree with a concentration in Gifted Education must complete a minimum of 33 hours of graduate level course work (50000 level and above only). This program includes 12 hours of Educational Psychology credits, 12 hours of Gifted Education credits, and 9 hours of elective coursework (see below). By the second semester of course work, students must plan their program and arrange with their advisor for signed approval of this program of study, which must then be filed in the Office of Graduate Student Services (White Hall 418). Any change in this plan must be approved by the advisor.
