







- Can receive one per semester
- Fall 2022
 - For travel between August 25th, 2022 January 16th, 2023
 - Deadline: September 5th, 2022

Spring 2023

- For travel between January 17th, 2023 May 17th, 2023
- Deadline: January 30th, 2023

• Summer 2023

- For travel between May 18th, 2023 August 23rd, 2023
- Deadline: May 29th, 2023



Awards: International Travel Award

- Competitive
- Supports attendance and travel to international conference
- Offers flat rate of \$1,500
- Can receive one per semester
