A minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA is required to declare the minor. Students are encouraged to declare the minor with a minimum of 3-4 semesters remaining before graduation and should meet with a faculty advisor to plan their course of study.

A minimum 2.75 GPA is required in the minor courses for graduation.

^{*}Students may register for HM 43030 and HM 43032 (with permission) without completion of the prerequisite courses. Students are expected to complete prerequisites for other courses within the minor unless permission is provided from instructor.

^{**}Students are encouraged to complete the majority of the required courses in the minor before taking practicum. Students who have completed a practicum/internship in another program area that had a significant hospitality component may be able to use the practicum/internship toward the practicum requirement in the minor with hospitality management faculty approval.

^{***}Enrollment in ACCT 23020 requires completion of a minimum of 28 semester hours.
