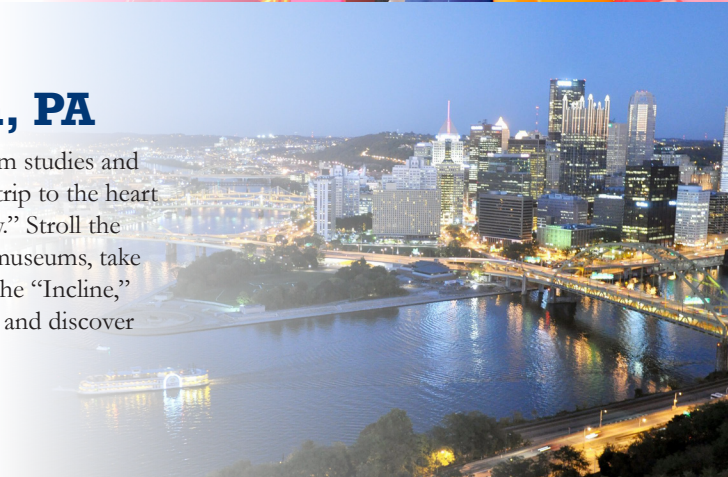
## April 2 Seasonal Shopping Spree

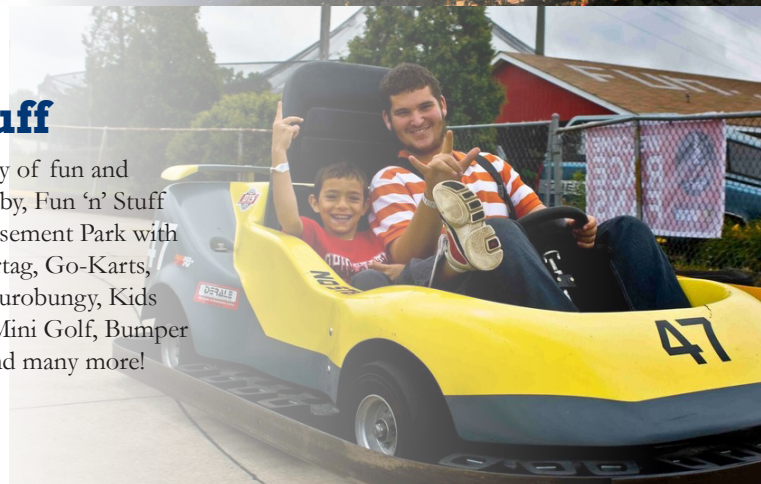
## April 16 Pittsburgh, PA
