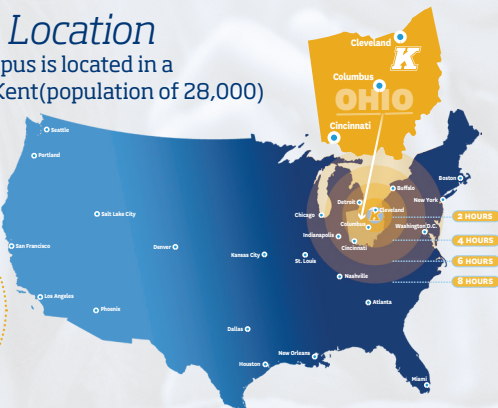

\*\*The Master of Architecture, Architecture & Environmental Design, Landscape & Architecture, Urban Design, and Healthcare Design programs typically add around \$1,500 extra in tuition costs.

For issuing I20's, additional proof of finances must also be provided for dependents as follows:

• \$4,500 for spouse or other first dependent • \$2,500 for each additional dependent

Kent State University requires all international students to purchase the sponsored student health insurance plan. Under certain criteria, a student may request a waiver of this charge.







# Undergraduate **International Scholarships**

**The Global Scholarship Helps a Kent State Education Connect You with Resources, People, and a World of Opportunities.**

Kent State established the Global Scholarship because it values diversity among its student population and as a result seeks to attract a greater number of high-quality international students to its campuses. The Global Scholarship is available to all incoming international undergraduate degree-seeking students who have been admitted to Kent State.

## **Admissions Requirements and Eligibility Amounts**

<b>High school or college GPA</b>	<b>Annual Scholarships/Renewable</b>
<b>Admitted to Honors College</b>	<b>\$15,000 + Honors Scholarship (\$2000*)</b>
<b>3.70+</b>	<b>\$12,000</b>
<b>3.6-3.69</b>	<b>\$10,000</b>
<b>3.5-3.59</b>	<b>\$7,000</b>
<b>3.49 and below</b>	<b>\$4,300</b>

Must be an incoming international undergraduate student (Freshman and transfer) on an F1/student visa attending the Kent State campus.

## **Application Process**

Students will be automatically considered for the Global Scholarship.

## **Application Deadlines**

Must be admitted by July 1st for Fall semester, November 1st for Spring semester and March 1st for Summer semester.

\* To be considered for the Honors Scholarship – must apply by December 1st for Spring semester, and January 15th for Fall semester.
