SUMMER INTENSIVE ARABIC Application Deadline: Early May Program Dates: Early June-Mid July



WHY STUDY AT AUC?

Located in the heart of the Middle East, The American University in Cairo (AUC) is a state-of-theart, US-accredited, English-language university. Established 100 years ago, AUC is one of the oldest liberal arts institutions in the region, continuing to serve as the intellectual, social, and cultural hub for the Arab world.

As a study abroad student at AUC, you will be directly enrolled in the University, allowing you to select courses from across our 37+ undergraduate programs. Since all courses are taught in English-except for the Arabic program-you will be fully integrated on our campus, sitting in class and sharing housing with your peers from Egypt and around the world. AUC is a study abroad destination where you can stay on track with your degree, hone your academic interests, and build lifelong friendships while you become immersed in a different culture.

AUC is one of the few universities in the Middle East that makes it relatively



easy for Americans to apply for a single semester and get full transferable credit; if you're interested in the region, definitely consider it! I've really valued my time here. My classes have been interesting, the campus is gorgeous, and the other students are super friendly and willing to help. Cairo is a very fun city - there are always new things going on, and outlets for any type of person. I didn't realize how much I would want to travel within Egypt before coming here, but I've found one semester to be not nearly enough to check out everything I have wanted to do.

ARABIC COURSES

AUC's language of instruction is English but you can enrich your study abroad experience by incorporating one or more Arabic classes into your schedule. AUC's world-renowned program accommodates students at all levels of language proficiency. AUC also offers an intensive Arabic program during the year and over the summer. COSTS

Listed below are estimated costs for a semester at AUC:

- Tuition: \$11,025 (15 credits)*
- Housing: \$1,125 (double room)
- Visas: \$125 (tourist + student visas)
- AUC Health Insurance: \$175
- Student Fees: \$155
- Food: \$2,000
- Airfare: \$1,200
- Personal Expenses: \$1,000-\$2,000
