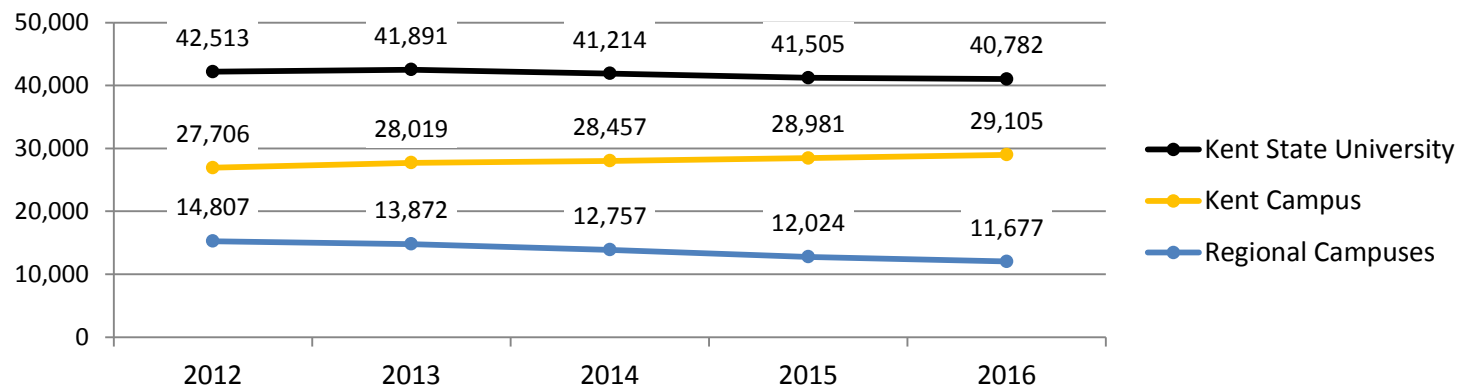
Student Enrollments
