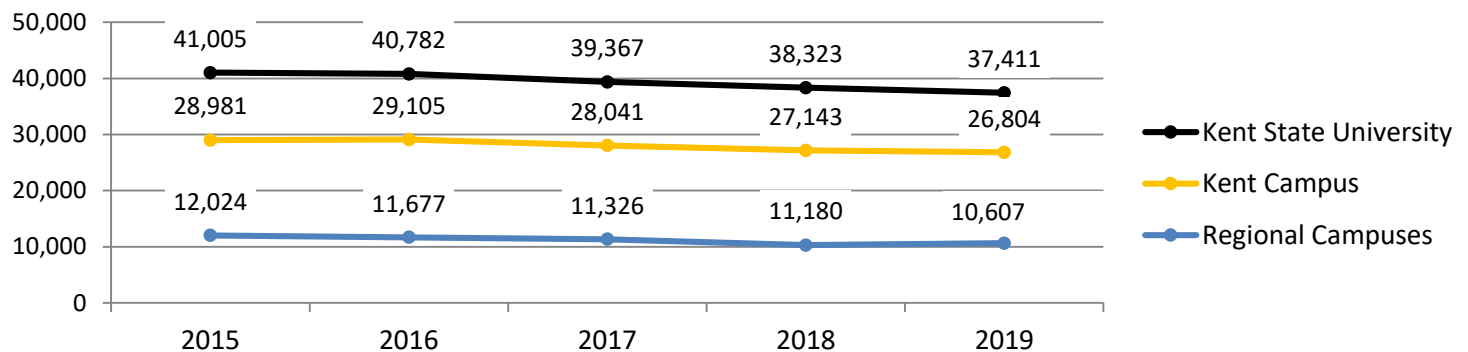
### Student Enrollments
