## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the East Liverpool Campus enrollment for the Spring 10 Term. The East Liverpool Campus experienced a $25.19 \%$ increase in student headcount; 1337 students in Spring 10 compared to 1068 students in Spring 09 for a net increase of 269 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by $25.21 \%$ (269 students) and graduate enrollment increased by $0 \%$ ( 0 students).

Student FTE increase by $18.12 \%$; the East Liverpool Campus generated 101.13 more FTE compared to Spring 09. Undergraduate FTE increased by $18.02 \%$ (100.53 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by $300 \%$ ( 0.6 FTE)

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 7.39 compared to 7.84 in Spring 09 . Graduate MUL is 12.0 compared to last year's 3.0 and the campus MUL is 7.40 compared to 7.84 last year.
