# FIFTEENTH DAY ENROLLMENT STATISTICS 

## Geauga Campus

Fall 10

## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Geauga Campus enrollment for the Fall 10 Term. The Geauga Campus experienced a $16.04 \%$ increase in student headcount; 2,199 students in Fall 10 compared to 1,895 students in Fall 09 for a net increase of 304 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by $16.12 \%$ ( 304 students) and graduate enrollment increased by $.00 \%$ (students).

Student FTE increased by $6.19 \%$; the Geauga Campus generated 57.27 more FTE compared to Fall 09 . Undergraduate FTE increased by $6.20 \%$ ( 57.27 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by $.00 \%$ (. 00 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 6.71 compared to 7.34 in Fall 09 . Graduate MUL is 3.00 compared to last year's 3.00 and the campus MUL is 6.70 compared to 7.32 last year.
