## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Geauga Campus enrollment for the Spring 10 Term. The Geauga Campus experienced a $32.21 \%$ increase in student headcount; 2040 students in Spring 10 compared to 1543 students in Spring 09 for a net increase of 497 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by $32.94 \%$ ( 501 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by $18.18 \%$ ( -4 students).
Student FTE increase by $28.11 \%$; the Geauga Campus generated 202.07 more FTE compared to Spring 09. Undergraduate FTE increased by $28.43 \%$ ( 203.07 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by $21.74 \%$ (-1.0 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 6.80 compared to 7.04 in Spring 09 . Graduate MUL is 3.0 compared to last year's 3.14 and the campus MUL is 6.77 compared to 6.99 last year.
