# FIFTEENTH DAY ENROLLMENT STATISTICS 

## Geauga Campus

Spring 11

## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Geauga Campus enrollment for the Spring 11 Term. The Geauga Campus experienced a $21.08 \%$ increase in student headcount; 2470 students in Spring 11 compared to 2040 students in Spring 10 for a net increase of 430 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by $21.41 \%$ ( 433 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by $16.67 \%$ ( -3 students).

Student FTE increase by $11.59 \%$; the Geauga Campus generated 106.73 more FTE compared to Spring 10. Undergraduate FTE increased by $11.69 \%$ ( 107.26 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by $14.72 \%$ ( -0.53 FTE)

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 6.26 compared to 6.80 in Spring 10. Graduate MUL is 3.07 compared to last year's 3.0 and the campus MUL is 6.24 compared to 6.77 last year.
