## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Trumbull Campus enrollment for the Spring 10 Term. The Trumbull Campus experienced a 17.83\% increase in student headcount; 2776 students in Spring 10 compared to 2356 students in Spring 09 for a net increase of 420 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by $17.99 \%$ ( 423 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by $60 \%$ ( -3 students).

Student FTE increase by $17.87 \%$; the Trumbull Campus generated 252.74 more FTE compared to Spring 09 . Undergraduate FTE increased by $17.93 \%$ ( 253.40 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by $58.41 \%$ ( -0.66 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 9.01 compared to 9.02 in Spring 09 . Graduate MUL is 3.50 compared to last year's 3.40 and the campus MUL is 9.01 compared to 9.01 last year.
