

Uploading Videos to Blackboard Learn

- **Upload clips to KSUtube first**
 - <http://ksu.tube.kent.edu/>
 - 1. Use your Flashline ID and password to log in.
 - 2. Click “choose file”
 - Valid file types include: mov, wmv, avi, mpg, rv, rm, ram, flv, mp4, m4v, mp3, wav, wma, mts.
 - Files must be less than 1GB in size. The limit is twice the size of Pearson.
 - File names cannot contain special characters i.e.: &, #, ', !, etc.
 - 3. Click “upload!”
 - 4. General Settings
 - Name video
 - Add description
 - 5. Security Settings
 - Select “Require Password”
 - Type in a password
 - 6. Advanced Settings
 - You must click on “Advanced Settings” to open the tab
 - Select 320x240 under “4:3 Standard”
 - 7. Click “Submit”
 - 8. You will receive a confirmation email once the video is ready with a link to the video. It may take around 20 minutes.

- **Copy embed code from KSUtube**
 1. Click the link to the video in the confirmation email.
 2. Enter your password to view the video.
 3. Copy the “Embed Code” by pressing CTRL-C (on Windows) or Command-C (Mac)

- **Login to Blackboard Learn**
 - <http://learn.kent.edu/>
 - 1. Use your Flashline ID and password to log in
 - 2. Choose the course you want to upload the video for.
 - 3. Navigate to where your instructor wants you to submit the file.
 - 4. Click on the toggle code button that looks like a pair of left and right arrows, such as <>. When you hover over the button, it will say “Toggle HTML Source Mode.”
 - 5. Paste the Embed Code by pressing CTRL-V (on Windows) or Command-V (Mac)
 - 6. Scroll down and click “Submit”
