Proposal to Revise Prerequisite for Student Teaching/Capstone Practicum for Initial Licensure at the Undergraduate and Graduate Level

Rationale: Those entering student teaching or other capstone practicum in teacher education need to be prepared to handle emergency situations involving the safety of K-12 students.

Purpose: The purpose of this proposal is to add three training sessions as prerequisites to the Student Teaching/Capstone Practicum for Initial Licensure at the Undergraduate and Graduate Level.

Candidates for student teaching must provide official certificates for Child Safety Training, Basic Life Support and A.L.I.C.E training to the campus office of clinical experiences in the semester prior to student teaching/Capstone Practicum as a prerequisite to registering for Student Teaching/Culminating Practicum.

- Child Safety Training: Four hour training session provided by a certified Ohio
 Department of Job and Family Services instructor. This training is mandated for all new
 school district employees. All aspects of child safety training will be included:
 Promoting mental and emotional health (depression, suicide, resilience, barriers to
 learning); promoting an alcohol, drug, and tobacco free life-style; preventing violence
 against children (teen dating violence, bullying and child abuse awareness and
 reporting). Cost is \$10.00 per candidate. Sessions will be held on Fridays and Saturdays
 throughout the year or during designated classes to be determined by program areas.
- Basic Life Support: Four hour training offered through Red Cross and Fire and Rescue services across the State (list of training site in our area is attached). Training includes CPR (Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation), AED (Automatic Electric Defibulator), and choking interventions. Cost is \$50.00 and certification is good for two years. A certificate will be provided. Candidates may also present a valid Red Cross First Aid/CPT certificate.
- A.L.I.C.E Training: 90 minute crisis training (Alert, Lockdown, Information, Counter and Evaluation) is offered free of charge to KSU students and employees through Public Safety in partnership with Human Resources. The session will provide insight and response options when encountering an active shooter. Sessions will be offered on Saturdays throughout the year for candidates or during designated classes to be determined by program areas.
