Background Information:

The University Catalog does not a have statement indicating a minimum grade requirement for Occupational Therapy Assistant Program and students need to be aware of this information.

.The new computer system "BANNER" states that the minimum grade requirement for OCAT courses is a "D". This statement is incorrect.

The Occupational Therapy Student Handbook states that students must earn a grade of "C" or better in all OCAT and related courses to progress and remain in the program. This is the information that is provided at student orientation.

program, graduates are awarded the Associate of Applied Science in Occupational Therapy Assistant Technology (OTAT) and are eligible to sit for the National Certification Examination for Occupational Therapy Assistants administered by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT). Admission to the OTAT major requires the following: admission to the university; completion of the COMPASS test and, if necessary, recommended coursework; a minimum of 40 hours of volunteer time in at least two different occupational therapy settings; high school or college courses in algebra and general biology; and a 2.5 GPA. Students interested in the program should apply directly to the Ashtabula or East Liverpool campus and meet with the program director. Applicants not admitted directly to the OTAT program will be admitted as pre-major students. Detailed information and requirements for admission may be obtained from the Kent State Ashtabula or East Liverpool campus program offices.
