### **Proposal Summary**

### Title

Revision to Anatomy and Physiology Biology course requirement for the Associate of Applied Science in Physical Therapist Assistant Technology (AAS PTST)

### Subject Specifications

The purpose of this proposal is to revise the biology requirement for the AAS in Physical Therapist Assistant Technology to ensure alignment with other allied health programs at Kent State University.

### **Background Information**

The Associate of Applied Science in Physical Therapist Assistant Technology is an established program that has utilized BSCI 11001, Anatomy for Physical and Occupational Therapy in the program curriculum. Since that time, BSCI 11010 and BSCI 11020 (Anatomy and Physiology for Allied Health I and II) have been developed and were approved by EPC for allied health majors. The proposal is to replace the BSCI 11001 requirement with BSCI 11010 and BSCI 11020. This revision will maintain consistency with the requirements for all other allied health programs at Kent State University.

The proposed change will be effective beginning with the fall 2009 semester when the AAS in Physical Therapist Assistant Technology will be first offered. Program brochures and other informational materials will reflect the change when this change is approved. This revision will increase the enrollment in BSCI 11010 and 11020, but BSCI 11001 has already been discontinued. These courses have already been listed as automatic substitutions for the BSCI 11001 course. These courses are already offered for other allied health majors at the Ashtabula campus and there is faculty available to teach the additional students. There is no anticipated fiscal impact to this change.

### Alternatives and Consequences

Failure to make approve this proposal would create a barrier to any student who wishes to change majors within the allied health field. As students often take their science requirements prior to entering an allied health program, this revision will allow students the flexibility to explore possible allied health options prior to program entry. This also spreads out the content of the course over two semesters to allow students more time to learn detailed information critical to this degree program.

### Specific Recommendation and Justification

The Associate of Applied Science in Physical Therapist Assistant Technology curriculum should be revised to replace BSCI 20020 (Biological Structure and Function) with BSCI 11010 and BSCI 11020 (Anatomy and Physiology for Allied Health I and II). This revision will maintain consistency with the requirements for all other allied health programs at Kent State University.
