# **Proposal Summary**

Title: Program Requirement Revisions for ECDE Undergraduate and Graduate Majors

**Subject Specification:** This proposal will revise program requirements for Bachelor of Science in Education and Master of Education degrees in Early Childhood Education [BSE ECDE, MEd ECDE]

Background Information: The Early Childhood Education faculty completed a self-study and holistic review of the program during academic year 2009-10. - Specify MATH 14002 Math Concepts II (4 cr) as requirement

# **Advanced Study Course Work for ECED:**

- Remove ECED 40151 Guidance of Young Children (3 cr) from major program requirements; rationale for this, is that the content will be included within another course, ECED 40128 Integrated Field Experience, which includes attention to integrated content and guidance issues in primary grades.
- Add to Program Requirements: newly-established course ECED 40123 Critical Inquiry into Integrated Curriculum in the Primary Years (3), to emphasize curriculum and assessment of the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Program (IB PYP) six content areas including a global emphasis on social studies and science.
- Change course sequence by moving ECED 40145 *Music and Rhythms* to Block I and ECED 30147 *Teaching Math and Science in the Early Years* to Block II to allow preservice teachers more practical preparation in songs, music, and rhythm earlier in the program and more methods work during the preschool internship.
- Course catalog updates are being submitted for ECED 20163 *Understanding Young Children* and ECED 40165 *Integrated Application of Preschool Curriculum*, to allow for clear integration of the IB PYP.

# Graduate

The following course catalog updates are being submitted for approval. The new course will be added to the list of electives for the MEd major.

- Establish a new course ECED 50123 Critical Inquiry into Integrated Curriculum in the Primary Years to emphasis curriculum and assessment of the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Program (IB PYP) six content areas including a global emphasis on social studies and science. Include self-assessment for global knowledge and awareness.
- Revise ECED 60152/70152 Application of Selected Theoretical Principles to the Development of Young Children, ECED 60113/70113 Preschool Education to update to contemporary thinking of theory and preschool curriculum, respectively, and to align courses with IB PYP philosophy, mission statement, etc., so that students can be prepared to apply for IB PYP teacher award.

# Timetable and Actions Required:

Revision of six courses (ECED 20163, ECED 40165, ECED 60152/70152, ECED 60113/70113) and establishment of two courses (ECED 40123/50123);

Change of Kent Core requirements and major program requirements in the undergraduate program; Revision of ECED graduate program courses to meet/align with IB PYP elements so that our students will have the opportunity to apply for IB teacher award program.

# Special Notes for Licensure:

- 1. Students must pass Praxis II "Principles of Learning and Teaching, Grades P-3" (minimum 166) and Praxis II specialty test "Education of Young Children" (minimum 166).
- Students must apply for teaching licensure (licensure packet available in 304 White Hall)

# Liberal Education Requirements (LER)

Students must complete a minimum 36 credit hours of Liberal Education Requirements. Colleges or degree programs may specify certain courses to fulfill the requirements. Courses in the students' major field will not count toward the completion of any LER. Honors equivalents shall satisfy the LER. None of the courses on the LER list may be taken with a pass/fail grade.

# **Diversity Course Requirement**

Students must complete a two-course diversity requirement, consisting of one with a domestic focus and one with a global focus. One course must be come from the LER and cannot be in the student's major. The second course may be taken as a second LER; or within a major or minor; or as a general elective; or, with dean's approval, by completing one semester of study in another country.

#### Writing-Intensive Course Requirement

Students must complete a one-course writing-intensive requirement in their major and earn minimum C (2.00) grade.

#### Upper-Division Requirement

In general, baccalaureate programs require the successful completion of at least 39 upper-division (numbered 30000 to 49999) credit hours of coursework. Programs in the College of Arts and Sciences require a minimum of 42 hours of upper-division coursework.
