## The Samuel Melton Scholarship

The Samuel Mendel Melton Scholarship provides financial assistance to selected students at Kent State University. The award is for \$1000 per semester for a maximum of eight semesters, as long as funds are available. Students, who will be Jewish Studies minors, **must** enroll in one or more courses in Jewish Studies each semester. A minimum 2.8 cumulative GPA is required for application and renewal.

Application procedure: (1) Complete an application form and essay and return them to the Jewish Studies Program office (Bowman 113-D). (2) Submit high school or college transcripts, proof of ACT/SAT scores, and two letters of recommendation from teachers/professors as soon as possible.
