Dissertation Committee

Your dissertation committee is composed of four members, three from within the Department of Political Science and one from outside the department. The Dissertation Committee is to assist you in developing your bibliographic essay, your preliminary research paper, and your dissertation prospectus. Once you have completed and defended the dissertation prospectus, the dissertation committee will supervise the writing of your dissertation. When the dissertation is completed and ready for defense, Graduate Studies will appoint a graduate representative, and your advisor will select a moderator for the dissertation oral examination.

Since the Dissertation Committee is primarily concerned with getting you through the dissertation, the members should be chosen with a view toward what they can contribute to the process; thus, Dissertation Committee members are normally faculty who have substantive or methodological interest in the dissertation topic.
