




Active, licensed Kent State University graduates from the last three years work in **52** of **88** Ohio counties and **244** school districts.

Program Highlights

Master of Arts in Teaching

Our Master of Arts in Teaching program has increased the breadth and depth of its partnerships with local public schools. For example, our teacher candidates complete summer projects with STEM camps at Maple Heights City Schools, as well as with the Bio-Med Science Academy (which is the only Ohio STEM-designated school set at a medical college).

These experiences provide our Master's-level teacher candidates with the opportunity to begin their professional presence on day one of their educator preparation program, ultimately ensuring that they will be well prepared for a wide range of teaching opportunities.
