Although I'm not a local pilot (I live in North Royalton, OH) I do fly into KSU Airport fairly regularly when I fly for the CAP (Civil Air Patrol) with Cadets as part of the Orientation Flight program (O-Flights). In addition to their CAP O-Flight credit I usually sign them up for EAA Young Eagles Credit! In addition to it being an easy flight from Cuyahoga County Airport (where our CAP C-172 is based), KSU Airport always seems to have friendly people around for the Kids to interact with. These are all highly motivated teenaged kids with a keen interest in aviation just a few years from entering college. On more than one occasion when the parents found out we were going to KSU Airport, they would say "we didn't know KSU had an airport or an Aviation Program." While I'm not saying that every kid that flys into KSU Airport will apply for admission, this airport, just by its existence, can

be considered a marketing and recruiting tool for the University.

Recently, the theory of non-linear systems, i.e. the "butterfly effect" has been much in vogue. I'm afraid that what would appear to be a straight

forward cost cutting exercise in disposing of "excess airport land" may have future unintended consequences for the institution. It would be a shame to see a fine flying field disappear.

I've spent 20 years as a Stow resident and another 8 as a Munroe Falls resident all of which has been under the flight path of the KSU airport operations. In addition to living in the vicinity of the airport I'm also a graduate of the Kent State Flight Program and now fly for a major airline out of Cleveland. I wouldn't be where I am today if it wasn't for the Kent State airport being a part of the Stow community. I remember visiting the airport with school groups as a child as well as attending airshows and firework displays. With the success of Aviation Day that tradition for Stow/Munroe Falls residents and their families is continuing.

Beyond my own personal history with the airport, the Kent State airport is a piece of Aviation History that shouldn't be casually tossed aside. When Kent State purchased the airport they became the curator for a piece of history. Stow history must be preserved especially when it's a piece of operating history such as this airport. We've all watched over the last decade as the remaining open pieces of land have been replaced with homes and businesses. With the development of the Call Farm, the Kent State Airport is one of the last few pieces of open land left. We don't need another commerce park or housing development here.

I'm well aware of the negative reaction from a small percentage of the Stow/Munroe Falls residents for both keeping the airport or giving it small improvements. I can also say from hearing them state their cases in person at the City Hall meetings that most have spent less than 5 years in our city. It was their choice to live in close proximity to the airport. Their obvious expectations that the airport would be removed in a few years or that it would never grow or improve it's facilities shows ignorance. It became clear that they never personally researched the airport operations prior to moving to the old Pambi Farm location. In less than 5 years they are demanding the removal of an airport that the rest of us have been living next to for over 20 years?!

It also became clear in those meetings that they don't understand the implications of airport improvements. Continually in print I'm see outcry at widening the runway. I can tell you a several thousand hour pilot that runway length is the only deciding factor when it comes to landing an aircraft. Width provides a margin of safety but doesn't permit larger aircraft to land.

The aviation community as well is watching closely. We all saw the black eye that Mayor Daly gave his city by shutting down Meigs Field in Chicago. Don't bring the same negative criticism to my community or my alma mater.

I can tell you a several thousand hour pilot that runway length is the only deciding factor when it comes to landing an aircraft. Width provides a margin of safety but doesn't permit larger aircraft to land.

The aviation community as well is watching closely. We all saw the black eye that Mayor Daly gave his city by shutting down Meigs Field in Chicago. Don't bring the same negative criticism to my community or my alma mater.

Heather Thank you very much for your comments regarding the Kent State Airport Master Plan. You have stated good questions

Regarding the wooded area should the airport expand or sell. We are now preparing the Analysis of Alternatives report. This document reviews the various options. Any expansion of the runway would be on a North/South axis and would not directly impact wooded area to the west of the runway. However a component of the Master Plan considers additional facilities to

support the airport activities. These facilities could be located in wooded area to the west of the runway. The wooded area to the north of the airport could be impacted should extension of runway to the north be deemed the best alternative for the twenty year planning horizon.

The analysis of alternatives will be discussed at a public meeting January 21, 7pm, Stow City Hall. We plan to have this chapter of the Master Plan report posted on the University Airport web site by January 5, 2004.

I can not address your question regarding the woods should the airport be relocated. The Master Plan looks for the best 20 year option for improving aviation and meeting community needs. Should the analysis reveal that a relocation of air activities is the best option further studies would be required.

Regarding your question on acreage of wooded area on the airport. I do not have surveyed information, looking at aerial photo's however I would guess that the wooded area to the west of the runway is about 30 acres. There are additional wooded areas that abut the airport property that I have not factored in. The wooded area to the north of the runway is about 15 acres.

Regarding your question about how many deer live in these woods. I have no idea. Safety at the airport is our number one priority at all times. We continually watch for deer in the area with the safety concern that deer may enter onto the runway during a take-off or landing.

Regarding your question on barriers protecting these woods if the airport is relocated. I am unsure what you mean by "barriers."
