# FIFTEENTH DAY ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

### 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent State University 8-Campus-System enrollment for the Summer III 12 Term. The Kent State University 8-Campus-System experienced a 4.25% decrease in unduplicated student headcount; 6,717 students in Summer III 12 compared to 7,015 students in Summer III 11 for a net decrease of 298 students. Undergraduate enrollment decreased by 6.25% (-345 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 3.14% (47 students).

Student FTE decrease by 4.01%; the Kent State University 8-Campus-System generated 36.89 less FTE compared to Summer III 11. Undergraduate FTE decreased by 4.08% (-28.65 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 3.77% (-8.24 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 1.95 compared to 1.91 in Summer III 11. Graduate MUL is 2.04 compared to last year's 2.19 and the campus MUL is 1.97 compared to 1.97 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
