## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Geauga Campus enrollment for the Summer I&II 13 Term. The Geauga Campus experienced a 9.35% decrease in student headcount; 892 students in Summer I&II 13 compared to 984 students in Summer I&II 12 for a net decrease of 92 students. Undergraduate enrollment decreased by 9.36% (-92 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 0% (0 students).

Student FTE decrease by 5.49%; the Geauga Campus generated 6.30 less FTE compared to Summer I&II 12. Undergraduate FTE decreased by 5.49% (-6.30 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 0% (0.00 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 1.83 compared to 1.75 in Summer I&II 12. Graduate MUL is 1.50 compared to last year's 1.50 and the campus MUL is 1.83 compared to 1.75 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
