## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Stark Campus enrollment for the Spring 12 Term. The Stark Campus experienced a 0.57% decrease in student headcount; 4,706 students in Spring 12 compared to 4,733 students in Spring 11 for a net decrease of 27 students. Undergraduate enrollment decreased by 0.36% (-17 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by 15.38% (-10 students).

Student FTE decrease by 3.42%; the Stark Campus generated 103.00 less FTE compared to Spring 11. Undergraduate FTE decreased by 3.27% (-97.80 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 29.55% (-5.20 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 9.34 compared to 9.62 in Spring 11. Graduate MUL is 3.38 compared to last year's 4.06 and the campus MUL is 9.27 compared to 9.54 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
