1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Stark Campus enrollment for the Fall 09 Term. The Stark Campus experienced a 11.89% increase in student headcount; 4414 students in Fall 09 compared to 3945 students in Fall 08 for a net increase of 469 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 11.84% (459 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 14.93% (10 students).

Student FTE increase by 11.95%; the Stark Campus generated 320.33 more FTE compared to Fall 08. Undergraduate FTE increased by 11.95% (318.20 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 11.19% (2.14 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 10.31 compared to 10.30 in Fall 08. Graduate MUL is 4.14 compared to last year's 4.28 and the campus MUL is 10.20 compared to 10.19 last year.
