## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Salem Campus enrollment for the Fall 11 Term. The Salem Campus experienced a 3.06% increase in student headcount; 2,023 students in Fall 11 compared to 1,963 students in Fall 10 for a net increase of 60 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 2.96% (58 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 66.67% (2 students).

Student FTE decrease by 0.66%; the Salem Campus generated 7.93 less FTE compared to Fall 10. Undergraduate FTE decreased by 0.69% (-8.33 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 59.70% (0.40 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 8.89 compared to 9.22 in Fall 10. Graduate MUL is 3.20 compared to last year's 3.33 and the campus MUL is 8.88 compared to 9.21 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
