## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Tuscarawas Campus enrollment for the Spring 11 Term. The Tuscarawas Campus experienced a 9.64% increase in student headcount; 2617 students in Spring 11 compared to 2387 students in Spring 10 for a net increase of 230 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 9.60% (229 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 100% (1 student).

Student FTE increase by 7.52%; the Tuscarawas Campus generated 115.60 more FTE compared to Spring 10. Undergraduate FTE increased by 7.51% (115.40 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 100% (0.2 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 9.47 compared to 9.66 in Spring 10. Graduate MUL is 3.0 compared to last year's 3.0 and the campus MUL is 9.47 compared to 9.65 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
