

# Master's Degree in Educational Technology with a Computer Science Endorsement

## Kent State University

### PROGRAM OF STUDY

Candidates for the Educational Technology (ETEC) master's degree with an Ohio Computer Science Endorsement must complete a minimum of 33 hours of graduate level course work. The program includes 12 hours of core requirements, 18 hours of additional required coursework, and 3 hours of a culminating experience. Other elective coursework may be included with the permission of the student's advisor. Students must have signed approval of a plan of study before registering for their third semester of coursework. The plan of study must be filed with the Office of Graduate Student Services (418 White Hall) or uploaded through the OGS forms page (<https://www.kent.edu/ehhs/ogs/forms>). Changes must be approved by the advisor before graduation. The Graduation Application (completed in FlashLine) is due no later than the 1st Friday of the term in which you plan to graduate.

There is an OAE (Ohio Assessments for Educators) content assessment for the Computer Science endorsement (test code: 054). Please visit the Pearson Education OAE website for test registration and test preparation information (<https://www.oh.nesinc.com/Home.aspx>). Upon successful completion of the endorsement coursework and OAE exam, the student must complete the online "Licensure Pre-Application" found in the student portal: <https://stuportal.ehhs.kent.edu/>. Please visit the Vacca Office of Student Services webpage (<https://www.kent.edu/ehhs/voss/how-apply-educator-license>) for instructions (pay close attention to the paragraph "Add an Endorsement or Teaching Field to an Existing License"). Once you have successfully completed and submitted your Licensure Pre-Application, the online system will connect you directly with the Ohio Department of Education's online licensure system where you will complete the process and make payment.
