



APPLICATION STEPS

NOMINATION	Students cannot apply by themselves; they must be nominated by their International Office by filling in this form. Semester 1: from 1st to 30th of April 2024 Semester 2: from 1st to 30th of September 2024
ONLINE APPLICATION	Once nominated, students will receive a confirmation from our International Office, together with an incoming student guide and a link to do their online application on our MoveOn platform.
	Semester 1: May 6th to May 31st 2024
	Semester 2: October 7th to October 31st 2024
	Students are not required to select their classes at this point yet.
ACCEPTATION	Once their application is completed, students will receive the list of classes available and will be assigned an International tutor to manage their academic questions.
	WARNING: selected classes before the arrival can be modified during the first week of
	the stay, due to last minute timetable modifications if we can offer alternative spots.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR ERASMUS STUDENTS	Certificate of Stay and Learning Agreements must be provided by the university of origin and will be signed by the international office upon arrival.






COURSES SELECTION

ECTS	There is a maximum number of ECTS credits that can be selected depending on the duration of stay at UE Valencia: 1 Semester: 30 ECTS 2 Semesters: 60 ECTS
	One subject usually represents 6 ECTS, meaning students can choose 5 subjects per semester. We will ask student to also choose two additional classes in case there is no place left in their first choice.
Language classes	UEV offers online English and Spanish classes (level A1, A2, B1 and B2). Registration for those classes are made during the first weeks of the stay via the webpage of the university.
	Face2face A1 Spanish classes (4h/week) are offered each semester.

	Due to the high demand on those programs, we cannot guarantee seats in those English classes and students may have no other option than following the Spanish equivalent. That is why a B2 in Spanish is highly recommended.
