# Study Abroad with a Cultural Internship in Korea for University Students

Internship	Intern as a "Cultural and Language Ambassador" through group meetings, language and cultural exchanges, and by living side by side with Korean students in specially designed dorms. Internship duties for group meetings and exchanges will be up to 15 hours per week.
Target Student	Native English speaking university students from partner institutions who wish to learn about Korean culture and want opportunities to share their home culture and language.
Duration	One to three semesters
Tuition	Full waiver
Airfare	Reimbursed up to ₩800,000 KRW (approximately \$ 710 USD)
Stipend	Weekly living expense support of ₩120,000 KRW (approximately \$110 USD) (11 weeks)
Room	Full waiver
