- General electives – any college level course not already completed.
- Up to 89 credits may be transferred into the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Applied Business degree from EGCC.

Requirements to graduate with the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Applied Business degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 120 credits hours, 39 upper-division credit hours of coursework, a minimum 2.0 major GPA and minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade. More specific graduation requirement information can be found in the Academic Policies section of the Kent State University Catalog (www.kent.edu/catalog).

Requirements to graduate with the Insurance Studies minor: To graduate, students must have a minimum of 18 credit hours, 6 upper-division credit hours of coursework, a minimum of 6 credit hours must be outside of the course requirements for any major or other minor the student is pursuing, a minimum of 50% of the total credit hours for the minor must be taken at Kent State (in residence), a minimum 2.00 GPA.
