 - SOC 110 Sociology of Marriage and Family will transfer to Kent Stat as HDFS/SOC 24011 Interpersonal Relationships and Families
- General electives – any college level course not already completed.
- Up to 86 credits may be transferred into the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Applied Business degree from EGCC.

Requirements to graduate with the Bachelor of Technical and Applied Studies in Nonprofit-Human Services degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 120 credit hours, 39 upper-division credit hours of coursework, a minimum 2.0 major GPA and minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade.
