Requirements to graduate with the BS degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 120 credit hours, 39 upper-division credit hours of coursework, a minimum 2.0 major GPA and minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade. 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It is recommended that students intending to pursue the Bachelor of Science in Public Health through Kent State University consult with academic advisors at both Columbus State Community College and Kent State University.
