Applied Translation Research Form

1. Have completed at least six (6) hours of coursework, 4 credits of which must be from MCLS 60010 Theory of Translation and appropriate ARAB, FR, GER, SPAN, JAPN, or RUSS Practice of Translation.
2. Have an overall GPA of 3.2 (graduate);
3. Agree that a portfolio of all work accomplished during the practicum will be submitted for evaluation to the Graduate Coordinator who will act as the practicum supervisor. The portfolio is the basis for evaluation of the course and should include a summary sheet indicating the *actual work hours* completed. No grade will be given if the portfolio is not received by the Graduate Coordinator before the end of the relevant grading period.
4. Secure the approval of a Translation Faculty Advisor and the Graduate Coordinator to obtain permission to enroll.
