SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION FOR BOTH NEW AND RETURNING STUDENTS:

- Kent State Tuscarawas and our Tuscarawas County University Foundation awards over \$375K in scholarship funds to over 250 new and returning students annually.
- Incoming freshmen do not need to complete an application to apply but must be admitted to Kent State Tuscarawas by Feb. 1 to be placed in a pool for priority selection.
 Exception The scholarships for Buckeye Career Center and Leaders of Tomorrow for new freshmen require a separate application to apply.
- Returning students must complete the Kent State Tuscarawas scholarship to apply for available scholarships. This application will be placed into a pool for the scholarship committee to review. Students only need to submit one application to apply for all available scholarships.
 May 1 is the annual deadline for returning students. Apply online at Returning Student Scholarship Application.
- Eligibility requirements, amount per award year and number of awards are subject to change.
