# GLOBAL VILLAGE

## Qualification

- Undergraduate or graduate students native or fluent in speaking one of the following languages
  - English, Spanish, Chinese, German, Russian, Portuguese, Japanese, French or Arabic
- Applications are only open to students participating the Academic Program

## GV Schedule

Period	June 20 ~ July 7, 2023 (3 weeks)
Orientation	June 20 ~ June 21, 2023 Participants will be given an information package containing materials for class instruction, books to use in class, a schedule, etc. Orientation is mandatory for all participants.
Classes	June 22 ~ July 7, 2023 2.5hours x 2sessions daily x 12days (Monday to Friday)
Teaching	Morning Session 9:30am ~ 12:00pm Afternoon Session 1:30pm ~ 4:00pm 5hours a day - total 60hours of teaching

## Location

- Campus: Jukjeon or Cheonan
- Classes can be on either campus depending on the language being taught.
- Teaching campus and peers will be assigned randomly.

The Global Village is a unique internship program teaching conversational language to DKU students. Participants will lead small groups in daily language classes for three weeks before continuing onto the Academic Program. This is a great opportunity to develop friendships with DKU students and gain insight into Korean culture from personal experiences. Also through teaching, you will gain valuable personal insights about yourself !

## Benefits

- Upon successful completion of the GV, (for leading two sessions)
    - ① Scholarship of flight reimbursement up to USD1000 or ② total 6 credits for internship/practicum
  - Internship Certificate of Achievement
  - Free on-campus accommodation during the GV period
- >> If a student decides not to go onto the Academic Program after completion of the GV, the student will not receive any benefits associated with GV participation.

# ACADEMIC PROGRAM

All courses are instructed in English by international and Dankook faculty.  
Participants can earn credits and join various cultural activities during the four week program.

## Location

Jukjeon Campus, Yongin, Korea

## Schedule

- Period **July 10 ~ August 3, 2023 (4 weeks)**
- Dorm move-in **July 8, 2023**
- Orientation **July 10, 2023**
- Classes & Activities **July 11 ~ August 3, 2023**
- Dorm move-out **August 4, 2023**



## Course Detail

- Course Dates **Monday through Thursday, no classes on Fridays, 4days/week**
- Course Times **Morning Class 9:00am ~ 12:00pm**  
**Afternoon Class 1:00pm ~ 4:00pm**
- Course Hours **3hours/day x 15days = 45hours per course**
- Credits **3 credits per course, students can take up to 2 courses**
- Lecture Topics **East Asian studies, business, economics, social sciences, IT, communications, history, global issues, fashion, theatre arts, tourism, Korean language, etc.**

## Optional Cultural Activities

- Cultural activities will follow classes every day and field trips are on Fridays
- Ceramic art, Korean arts and craft, nonverbal musical, Korean traditional music, DMZ/JSA tour, Temple Stay, Mud Festival, Taekwondo, visit to a Korean company, amusement park, Folk Village, etc.
- Students can select activities during the application period and pay for the selected activities at the orientation



## Program Fee

- Includes: Application fee (USD100), tuition, accommodation (USD500), student fees
  - For taking 2 courses : USD2800
  - For taking 1 course : USD1800
- Available Scholarships (only applicable for taking 2 courses)
  - USD1000 (discount) : DKU Partner University students, ISS returnee, DKU Alumni family
  - Program fee is waived for exchange students participating under student exchange agreement

# KOREAN IMMERSION PROGRAM

Students can be fully immersed in Korean culture by learning the Korean language and participating in various activities and field trips during this three week intensive program.

## Korean Language

- Course Dates Monday ~ Friday, 5 days/week
- Course Times 9:00am ~ 1:00pm
- Course Hours Total 45hours/course
- Placement Test On the first day of class

## Korean Village

The Korean Village is a peer-to-peer language learning opportunity. Dankook students will be matched with a small group of participants to help practice conversational Korean. It's also a great chance to get to know more about Korea through a friendship with a Korean peer.

## Optional Cultural Activities

- Cultural activities will follow classes every day
- Amusement Park (Everland), Taekwondo, Korean Traditional Music, Korean Traditional Dance, K-pop Dance, Korean Movie, Making Kimchi, DMZ/JSA, etc.
- Students can select and pay for the optional cultural activities during the orientation

## Credits

- Upon completion, students can earn 3 credits for Korean language course
- Upon participation in over 70% of the cultural activities, students can receive additional 3 credits for Korean Culture Studies
- To transfer credits, students are advised to consult with an academic advisor at their home university and obtain pre-approval to receive credits for coursework from DKU

## Program Fee

- Program Fee: USD1200
  - Includes: application fee (USD100), student fees, Korean language course, Korean Village and accommodation (USD400)
- Available Scholarships
  - USD200 (discount): DKU alumni family, Participants from partner university, ISS returnee
- Program fee is waived for exchange students participating under student exchange agreement
