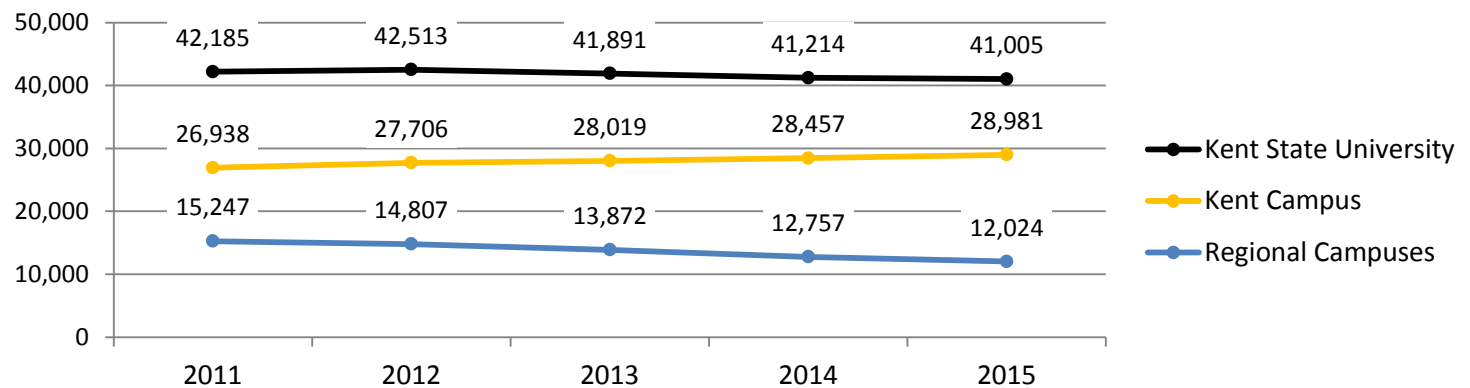
Student Enrollments
